Who are Parent Link Workers?

Parent Link Workers work in partnership with parents and carers to help them to access information about activities and services they might need.

They do this by:

- Being the school's first point of contact for parents and carers
- Providing information, sign-posting and guidance to agencies who may be able to offer support to families
- Providing information and guidance to parents and carers about after-school and holiday activities
- Providing information about courses available to parents and carers, information evenings and activities within the school or local cluster of schools and in the community

Parents and carers are able to contact their Parent Link Worker themselves by telephone or in person.

Parent Link Workers are able to offer information and advice and they will also try to find the right person to help with more complex family situations.
