

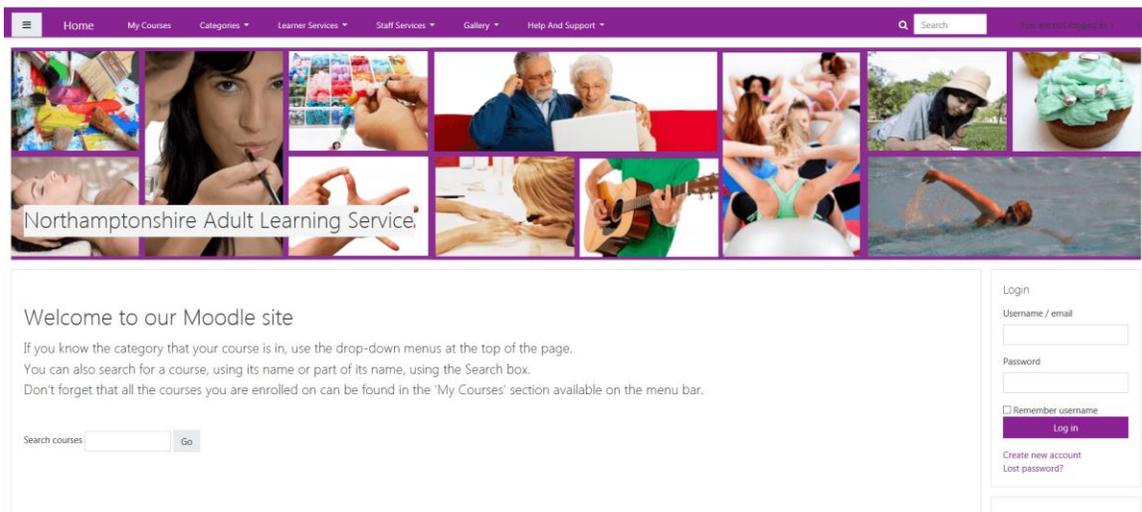
Creating a Moodle Login

To access some of the content on the Northants Adult Learning VLE (Virtual Learning Environment) you have to create your own username and password.

You must be able to access your email to receive confirmation and get into Moodle for the first time. After the first confirmation using your email address, you can log in from anywhere that you can access the internet, by using your username and password.

First click on the link below to take you to our Moodle homepage:

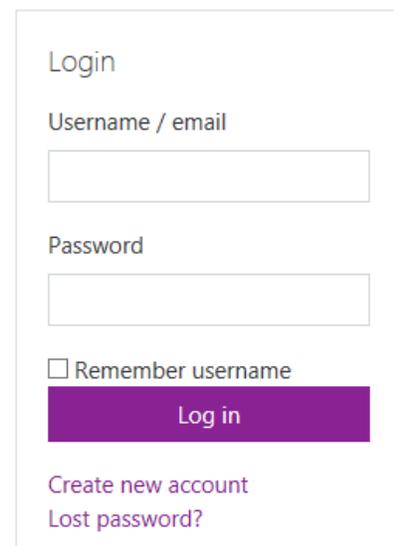

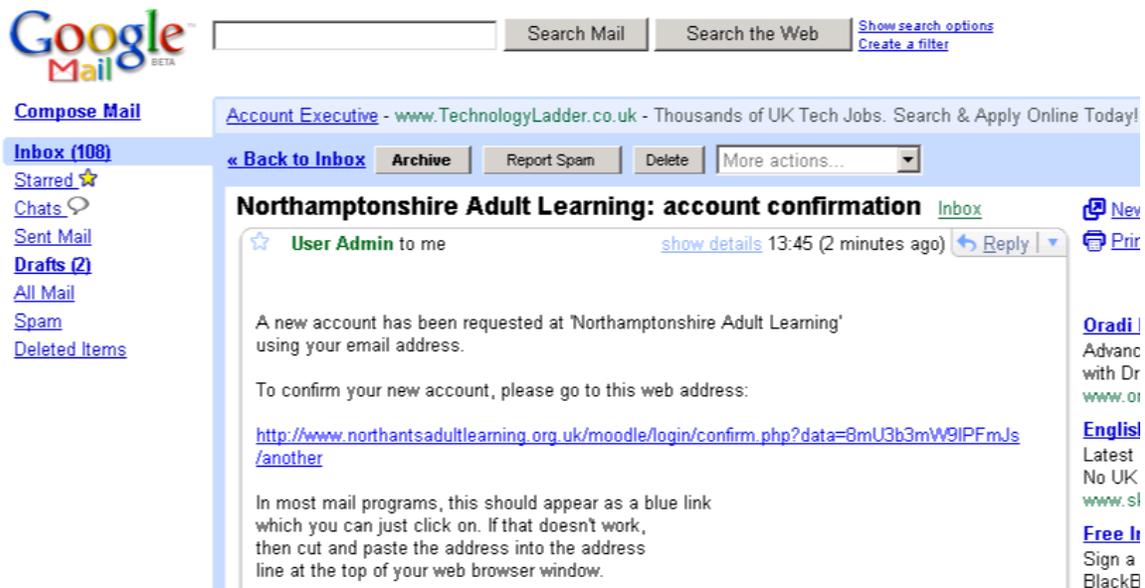

Click on the link in your email and it will take you to back into **MOODLE** and confirm that you have been registered. If you do not appear to have received the e-mail within 24 hours then check your 'Junk' or 'Spam' mail files - some e-mail systems treat all automatically generated mail as spam.

When navigating the site, you will see your name at the top right of the page indicating that you have logged in.
