Adult Mental Health Services in Northamptonshire NHS Nene and Corby Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG) and Northamptonshire County Council want to hear from people with experiences of Northamptonshire adult mental health services to help them plan for the future. We are reviewing services and developing a new mental health strategy. Your feedback and comments are vital in getting it right.

Dr David Smart, a GP from Northamptonshire and clinical lead for mental health, called for people to get involved in developing mental health services in the county.
