What is this consultation about?*

As a council, it is always important for us to live within our means and get the best value we can for the money we spend. That means getting the best value for Northamptonshire residents and others who use our services. To do that, we want to make sure we give priority to the things that matter most to residents and look after the most vulnerable people in our county. We must also make sure that we do what we have to do by law. We want to improve the way we prioritise both the outcomes we want to achieve and where we allocate our resources.

We are therefore introducing a new prioritisation framework with a process for using it. The framework includes a statement of the principles and values that drive our priority setting. A set of prioritisation criteria and a process to apply them will also be introduced to help decision makers to think consistently about all our options and prioritise them in a way that is open, fair and can be defended. The process will require some involvement from customers and partner organisations, from time to time, and will build on our usual consultation processes.

Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) would like to know your views about this planned change and the introduction of the framework and supporting process. We are not consulting on what our priorities should be at this stage.
