Minerals and Waste Local Plan Update - Final Draft Plan Northamptonshire County Council is undertaking an Update to the Minerals and Waste Local Plan adopted in October 2014. This is to ensure we continue to have an up to date plan in line with government guidance. This Update is concentrating on the minerals and waste allocations and designations and the approach taken to these.

The current stage of the Update process is what we have called the Final Draft Plan. This is the document that we consider, after reviewing the comments made at Draft Plan stage and amending the Draft Plan as appropriate, should be adopted as the new Minerals and Waste Local Plan. None of the amendments made from the Draft Plan to the Final Draft Plan are considered to be major, i.e. that alter the plans intent.

As most of the Local Plan is simply being carried forward unchanged, these unchanged elements are not being specifically consulted on. The Draft Local Plan therefore underlines the new/changed parts and those excluded from it are crossed out. Representations should focus on these changes.

submitted for its examination. This examination will be by an independent Planning Inspector who will examine the plan for its soundness. The Inspector may hold one or more public hearings into the Plan. The examination will assess the Plan against a number of tests of soundness. To be 'sound' the Plan should be positively prepared, justified, effective and consistent with national policy. The plan should also meet legal and procedural requirements and be in accordance with the Duty to Co-operate. More information on this is contained in Appendix 7 of the Final Draft Plan. Representations on the Plan should be made on the basis of compliance/non-compliance with the legal requirements and on meeting the tests of soundness.

The Inspector's Report on the Plan is expected at the end of March/Early April 2017, after which the Minerals and Waste Local Plan can proceed to adoption. All those who made representations on the Draft Plan will be notified when the Inspector's Report is published and where on the website they can view it.
