Developed initially by Northamptonshire Police, through  
engagement with a range of stakeholders, including  
community groups, the draft strategy has now been  
embraced as a partnership strategy document. It has  
further been endorsed by the Northamptonshire Chief  
Executives' Group for consultation. It sets out the joint  
vision, aims and objectives of key partner agencies that  
are responsible for tackling hate related incidents in  
Northamptonshire.

The agreed vision is:

"We will work in partnership to help make  
Northamptonshire the safest place in England by  
providing an excellent service to victim and witnesses of  
hate crime, focusing on prevention, early intervention  
and robust enforcement."

The aim of this consultation is to assist the partners to  
determine whether the draft key objectives - which  
place a significant focus on preventative work - are  
appropriate and fit for purpose in the reduction of hate  
incidents in the county.

These objectives are:

- Prevention and Early Intervention - Breaking the Cycle.
- Dealing with Perpetrators.
- Pathways of Support for Victims and Witnesses.
- Communication: Training, Public Awareness and  
Information Sharing.

Local delivery plans will be produced based on the final  
strategy.
