What is the consultation title?*

Northamptonshire Safeguarding Adults Board Strategic Plan 2016-19

What is this consultation about?*

Driven by the requirements of the Care Act 2014, Northamptonshire County Council on behalf of the Northamptonshire Safeguarding Adults Board (NSAB), are seeking feedback on the draft NSAB Strategic Plan 2016-19. The Strategic Plan sets out the vision, strategic priorities, and workstreams of the partnership responsible for Safeguarding Adults in Northamptonshire.

The draft Strategic Plan is based on the six core principles set out by Central Government:

- Empowerment - person led decision making and informed consent
- Protection - support and representation for those in greatest need
- Prevention - taking action before harm occurs
- Proportionality - proportionate and least intrusive response, appropriate to risk
- Partnership - local solutions through services working with their communities
- Accountability - accountability and transparency in delivering safeguarding

These core principles help to measure existing adult safeguarding arrangements and to measure future improvements. This draft Strategic Plan has been developed in partnership with the NSAB member organisations and the NSAB Users and Carers Sub-Group.

Much of the Strategic Plan is defined by Central Government, however there are some aspects which are open to local decision and can be decided by the NSAB, including Section 3 of the Strategic Plan which has a chart that features these aspects and workstreams.

The aim of this consultation is to assist the partners of the NSAB to determine whether the contents of the Strategic Plan, especially the workstreams aligned to the principles set out by Central Government are appropriate and fit for purpose to ensure that partners work together, alongside individuals and communities to safeguard adults in ways that supports them to make informed choices, and enabling them to have control in how they will live their lives.
