

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER (TEMPORARY)

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTIONS 257 AND 261

NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

THE NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY GF17 (PART) -  
PARISH OF CRANFORD) TEMPORARY DIVERSION ORDER 1996

This Order is made by Northamptonshire County Council under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the bridleway to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permissions numbered KE/90/369 and KE/92/496 granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for the surface working of minerals and the footpath can be restored at the end of a period not exceeding nine years.

BY THIS ORDER :

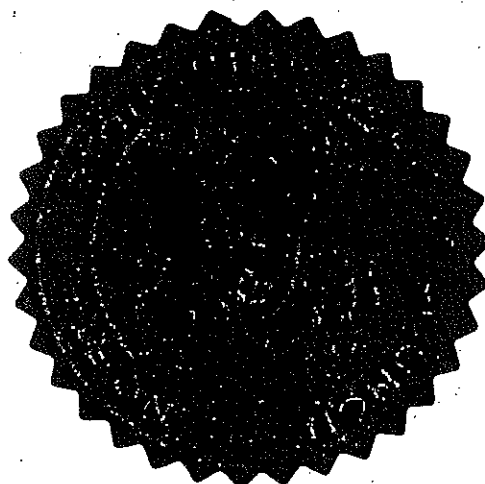
1. The bridleway over the land shown by a bold black line with cross bars on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below for a period not exceeding 9 years.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Northamptonshire County Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said bridleway as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black line on the attached map for a period not exceeding 9 years.
3. The diversion of the bridleway shall have effect 42 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
4. Before the expiration of the said 9 years the bridleway described in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be restored to its definitive route to the satisfaction of the Northamptonshire County Council.
5. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule:
  - (i) That a 3 metre wide level and even route be provided and maintained by the applicant throughout the temporary closure of public bridleway GF17.
  - (ii) That the temporary alternative route be separated from the workings on the site by a post and wire fence.
  - (iii) That the alternative route is not used by any of the site machinery.
  - (iv) The alternative route will be maintained by Nene Valley Waste Limited to the satisfaction of the County Council.
  - (v) The applicant shall be responsible for providing and maintaining any gates or other highway furniture required by Northamptonshire County Council on the alternative route.
6. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 1 of the Schedule on or before the expiration of 9 years from the date this order takes effect:

- (i) The path be restored to a width of 3 metres and shall be of a level and even condition.
- (ii) That at no point along the restored bridleway shall there be an incline steeper than 1 in 20.
- (iii) The land on which the line of the public bridleway is to be restored shall be reinstated in accordance with the relevant requirements of the conditions of the Planning Permissions numbered KE/90/369 and KE/92/496.

This order shall be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (Public Bridleway GF17 (Part) - Parish of Cranford) Temporary Diversion Order 1996."

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Bridleway

Part of public bridleway No. GF17 in the parish of Cranford from a point where it enters the southern perimeter of the landfill site at Grid Reference SP 93127610 and thence running in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 550m to a field boundary at Grid Reference SP 92847657, as shown A-D on the map annexed.

PART 2

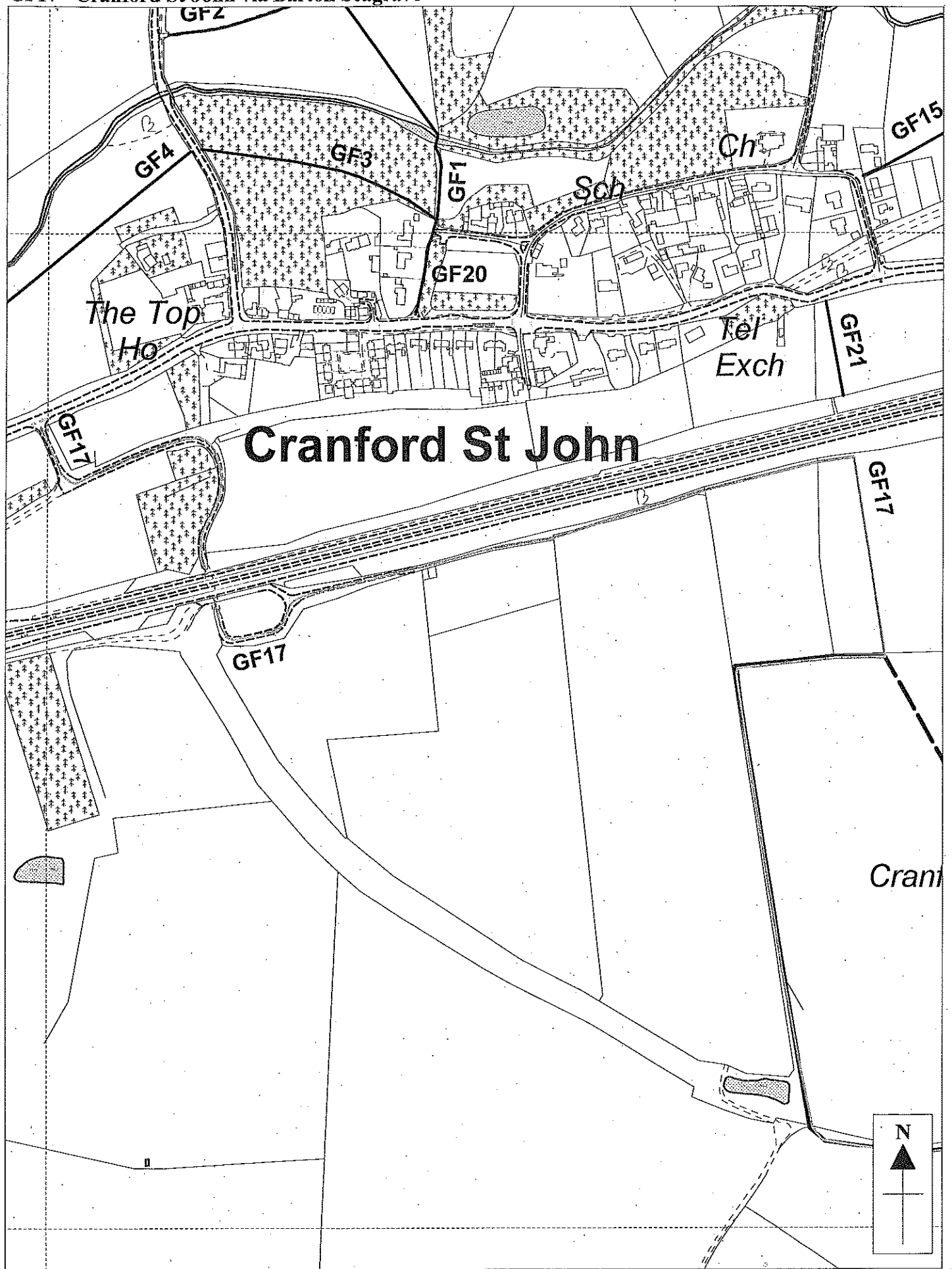
Description of Site of Alternative Bridleway

A bridleway that extends from public Bridleway No. GF17 in the parish of Cranford immediately inside the southern perimeter fence of the landfill site at Grid Reference SP 93127610 thence in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 360m to Grid Reference SP 92777610 and thence in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 460m to Grid Reference SP 92697656 and thence in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 150m to Grid Reference SP 92847657 and the continuation northwards of Bridleway GF17; this alternative route to be inside the perimeter fence of the existing and proposed extension of the landfill site, as shown A-B-C-D on the map annexed. The path is to be 3 metres wide.
