EN/02/846C and 13/00074/MINVOC.*

Except where modified by this schedule of conditions, the development shall be carried out in accordance with the submitted applications (Applications 2 & 3), Environmental Statement and associated drawings, and drawing nos. 95010/R/A, 95010/R/2a and 95010/R/2b, 95010/R/3 and 95010/R/4 approved under permission ref. no. EN/02/846C and 13/00074/MINVOC.
