Hereby give notice in pursuance of the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 that **permission has been granted** for the carrying out of the development referred to in Part I hereof in accordance with the application and plans submitted subject to the following conditions:-

Time Limit

1. This permission shall be limited to a period of time expiring 30 November 2011. At or before the expiration of this period, the mobile classroom shall be removed and the site restored to its former condition.

Note: This permission only relates to planning permission and does not include consent under the Building Regulations for which separate permission may be required. The requirements of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970, the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 and the Special Education Needs and Disability Act 2001 should also be adhered to wherever appropriate.

Scope of Permission

2. Except as otherwise required by conditions attached to this planning permission the development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the submitted application i.e. "Site Plan – Woodford Halse Church of England School and Youth Centre" (drawing No: D0212A)

"Floor and Elevation Plans" dated August 2006 and Planning Support Statement.
