Proposal:

Lorry route approval under Schedule 17 (6) to the High-Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Act to/from Greatworth Green Tunnel compound for highways, structures, earthworks and utility works.

Route 1: M40 Junction 11 and east on to the A422 towards Middleton Cheney for a distance of 1.65km. Then turn north east on to the B4525 Thorpe Lane and continue for a distance of 6.5km. Then turn north on to Sulgrave Road and continue for a distance of 0.9km to the compound entrance

Route 2: A43 and west onto the B4525 and continue for a distance of 8.9km. Then turn north on to Sulgrave Road and continue for a distance of 0.9km to the compound entrance


