Hereby give notice in pursuance of the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 that the non-material amendment referred to in Part I hereof has been granted with the amendments set out below:

With the exception of the changes resulting in this non-material amendment all of the conditions on planning permission ref: 08/00026/MIN and 16/00051/MINNMA (plant site and site infrastructure) remain applicable.

Note: This permission only relates to planning permission and does not include consent under the Building Regulations for which separate permission may be required. The requirements of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970, the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 and the Special Education Needs and Disability Act 2001 should also be adhered to wherever appropriate.

1. The mineral processing area and site infrastructure and soils storage mounds shall be located as identified on Drawing no. W4/901 Rev A dated 02/06/2016 and W4/902 Rev A dated 27/12/2016.
2. The mineral processing area shall be screened by the Bund 4 screening mound and the 5m high overburden mound as identified on Drawing W4/902 Rev A.
3. Mineral stockpiles shall not exceed the 5m height of the subsoil screening mounds.
