#### REASONS FOR REFUSAL OF AMENDMENT

1. The proposed amendment to the approved development (EN.97.522C) will increase the operating hours at the quarry which would increase the daily, weekday period of amenity impact by virtue of potential noise disturbance at noise sensitive receptors and as such it is considered to constitute a material change which will require planning permission.
