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Method of Working and Operational Limits

7. Except where modified by conditions below in this permission mineral extraction, processing, soil and mineral storage, infilling and restoration operations on the permission site shall only be laid out and undertaken in accordance with: plan/drawing no. **P14/PL15/07B** dated 08/15 (submitted on 18/08/2015); the processing plant as approved under permission ref. no. 14/00061/MINMA; and, plan/drawing no. **P14/PL14/03B** (Proposed Working Plan); and carried out in a sequential and phased manner in accordance with plan/drawing nos. **P14/PL14/03B (Proposed Working Plan)**, **P14/PL15/0301B (Phase 10)**, **P14/PL15/0302A (dated 03/16) (Phase 11)**, and **P14/PL15/0303 (Phase 12)** submitted with this planning application, and section 3.2 of the Working Scheme within the Environmental Statement (as updated 03/04/16). No more than 2 phases of the development shall be active at any one time, and no part of the operations specified therein shall be amended or omitted without the prior written approval of the Mineral Planning Authority.

11. No stockpiling or storing of minerals, mineral waste, topsoil, subsoil or overburden shall take place on the site or adjacent to it without the prior written approval of the Mineral Planning Authority, except in the locations as shown on plan/drawing no. **P14/PL15/07B** (dated 08/15, submitted on 18/08/2015) and plan/drawing no. **P14/PL14/03B** (Proposed Working Plan). All stockpiles or stores of minerals, mineral waste, topsoil or subsoil shall be no higher than 6m unless otherwise approved in writing under this condition by the Mineral Planning Authority.

Highways and Access

26. The vehicular access and internal haul road between the public highway and wheel wash as indicated on plan/drawing no. **P14/PL15/07B** (dated 08/15) shall be hardsurfaced, with the haul road from the processing plant to the public highway maintained in a good state of repair and kept clean and free of mud, dust and other debris at all times until completion of site restoration and aftercare, to ensure that such material is not carried onto the public highway.

Water resources and Pollution Prevention

33. The siltation lagoons shall be laid out, retained and operated as shown on plan/drawing no. **P14/PL15/07B** dated 08/15, and the IBD drain located east of Phase 10B and south of Phase 10A and 11 shall be monitored to ensure it is maintained in a waterbound state.

Informative

With the exception of the changes resulting in this non-material amendment all of the conditions remain applicable on planning permission ref: 16/00014/MINVOC.
