

## Landfill Capacity- Non-inert/Inert

The total available capacity as at end 2011 is:

Non-inert 8.13 mt  
Inert 7.13 mt

### Non-inert

Household Industrial Commercial (HIC) exported from Northamptonshire - interrogator is not returning any exports from Northamptonshire apart from 822 tonnes to hazardous restricted landfill (50 tonnes to Lincolnshire and 772 tonnes to Stoke on Trent).

HIC received at non-inert landfills in Northamptonshire totalled 383,867 tonnes (of which 105,835 was imported and originated from Bedfordshire, London, Norfolk, Hertfordshire, Warwickshire, Cambridgeshire, Essex, Kent, Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Milton Keynes, Rutland). Of the waste imported 12,882 tonnes was disposed of to non-hazardous (SNRHW) landfill with the remainder going to non-hazardous landfill.

### Inert

2012

Inert waste exported from Northamptonshire to inert landfill in Lincolnshire 22 tonnes.

Inert waste received at inert landfill in Northamptonshire totalled 597,098 tonnes (of which 196,701 was imported and originated from Buckinghamshire, Cambridgeshire, Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Rutland, Bedfordshire and unknown).

If above rates continues then landfill capacity would run out:

$8.13\text{Mt} / 0.38 = 21.4$  years non inert capacity (therefore beyond plan period)  
 $7.13\text{Mt} / 0.60 = 11.8$  years inert capacity
