Notice of Landowner Deposit

Section 15A(1) of the Commons Act 2006

An application to deposit a Statement under Section 15A(1) of the Commons Act 2006 has been made in relation to the land described below and indicated on the accompanying map(s).

This deposit may affect rights over the land described below. Deposits made under Section 15A(1) of the Commons Act 2006 may affect the ability to register such land as a Town or Village Green under Section 15 of that Act. Briefly, the deposit constitutes a mechanism whereby a landowner may bring to an end any period during which the public has indulged as of right in lawful sports and pastimes on the land, thus making it more difficult if not impossible for anyone to claim successfully that the land has become a village green.
