Northampton Bus Interchange bay changes

Following the introduction of additional bus stops in Mercers Row from Friday 18th December the following bay changes will be made.

Stagecoach Service 88 will move from Bay 17 to Bay 16.

Stagecoach Services 11/11A and X6 will move from Bay 18 to Mercers Row.

Stagecoach Midlands

From Sunday 20th June Stagecoach will be making timetable changes on some services following an update to the national Covid-19 guidelines to increase the number of passengers allowed to travel on public bus services.
